

Guidance: The Residual Drug Feedback Timeline is a pictorial representation of rings dispensed at each study visit and when residual drug feedback on each of those rings will be available to share with participants. The top row of the chart shows rings dispensed and the bottom row shows residual drug feedback availability. For instance, you can see that the clinic will receive residual drug feedback on the red ring dispensed at enrollment by the time the participant returns for her month 3 visit. **This tool is intended primarily as a training tool and reference for study staff.** HIV prevention options counselors may find it helpful to have a copy in their counseling room as well, in case they need it to explain to the participant which ring is being discussed during the counseling session.

NOTE: In some cases, residual drug data may be available earlier than listed (e.g., rings returned at Months 1 and 2 may sometimes be available by the Month 3 counseling session). All available results at the time of the visit should be provided to participants during their Options counseling session. In the event that results are not available, the visit should proceed as originally scheduled and the participant should be counseled that she will be contacted when this information is available.
